2. Apply in person at either office. Bring a photo ID, tax return, prescription bottles, and proof of income.

DO I QUALIFY?

In order to qualify for services:

- ✓ You must have no prescription coverage. Cannot have Medicaid or Medicare Part D.
- ✓ You must reside in Sarasota County and have a valid photo ID.
- ✓ In order to receive on-site pharmacy services, your family must meet eligibility guidelines:

<u>Household</u>	<u>Monthly Income Limit</u>
1	\$2,792
2	\$3,782
3	\$4,772
4	\$5,762

Household size is determined by your income tax return.

Only the last four weeks of income is used to determine eligibility, not the amount of your adjusted gross income on your tax return.

READY TO APPLY?

Be sure to bring the following items with you to our offices:

- Copy of your 2012 Tax Return.
- Copy of your Florida issued photo ID showing a Sarasota County address.
- Copies of proof of income for the last 4 weeks in the form of paystubs, social security or unemployment pay stubs for every household member.
- Prescription Bottles or Written Prescriptions.
